GOALS:

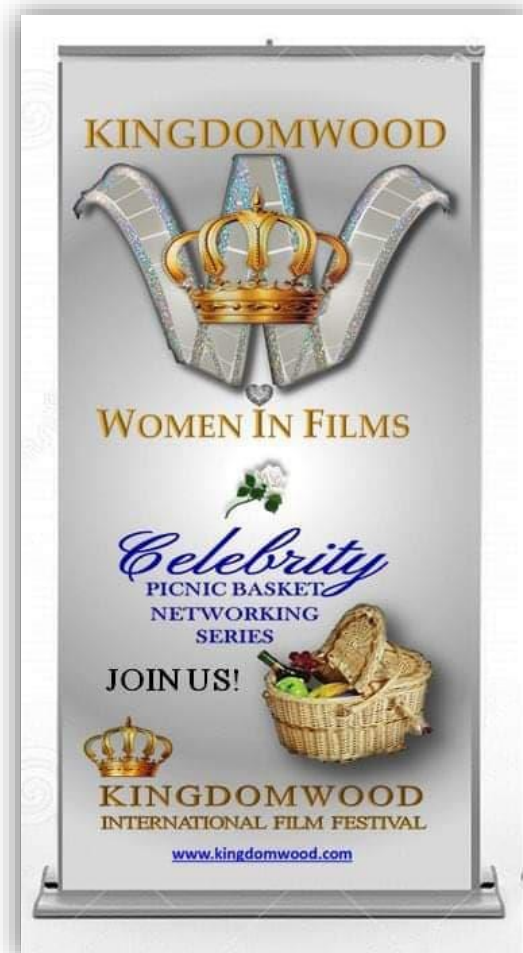
