Kingdomwood International Film Festival October 3-6, 2019

Atlanta, GA – The annual Kingdomwood International Film Festival is returning for its 11th year. Starting Thursday, October 3rd through Sunday, October 6th the Kingdomwood International Film Festival (“Kingdomwood”) will screen Christian films from around the world, at First Christian Church of Atlanta, 4532 LaVista Road Tucker, GA 30084.

Within in the four days there will be: a 48Hr Film Competition, Dual Red-Carpet Complimentary Movie Premiere, Red Carpet Comedy Show, Couple’s Improv Theater, Keynote Speaker, Red Carpet Jazz Concert, and an Award Presentation. In addition, there will be an all-day movie screening, workshop discussions, master classes, live presentations, script analysis and much more.

The festival will kick-off the afternoon of Thursday, October 3rd with Kingdomwood and the REEL Experience Studios’ Unique 48-hour film challenge, focusing on showcasing film maker’s authentic, artistic voices. Seven teams will have 48 hours to create a 5-7 minute short film on site.

Thursday evening Kingdomwood will be sponsoring a Complimentary Dual Red-Carpet Movie Premiere at 7:00 pm. Guests will be able to choose between the following movies: “Max Winslow and the House of Secrets,” or “The Freshman.”

Kingdomwood’s Keynote Speaker Ric Reitz is scheduled to speak on Friday, October, 4th at 10 am. Mr. Reitz is an actor, writer, composer, director and producer who has been active in show business for more than 40 years.

Friday evening starting at 7:30 pm, there will be a Red-Carpet Comedy Show moderated by Bob Cleveland and performances by Comedians Laura Little & Jonathan Nicolas.

On Saturday at 11:00 am, couples will have a once in a lifetime experience to participate in a improv theater with actors LaParee Young and Jen Harper from the hit show “Greenleaf”.

Saturday evening starting at 7:30 pm, there will be a Red-Carpet Gospel Jazz Concert featuring James Cockerham.

MAX WINSLOW AND THE HOUSE OF SECRETS:

Written by Jeff Wild and directed by Sean Olson. This movie is about five teenagers who compete to win a mansion owned by entrepreneur and scientist Atticus Virtue. To win, the teens must face-off against a super computer named Haven who controls the mansion.

FRESHMAN YEAR:

Written by Jude Okwudiafor Johnson and Toby Osborne, and directed by Okwudiafor Johnson. The story is about a Christian high school graduate who is challenged by social and peer pressure during his freshman year in a state university.
